



The Town of Rosemère is currently looking to recruit five residents who are interested in volunteering on the very first Civic Committee on the Environment.

### **The Committee's role**

The main role of this consultation committee is to ensure the enhancement and promotion of the Town's green vision. It will be called upon to provide recommendations to Town Council on activities, projects or guidelines that may have an impact on the following three aspects:

#### 1) ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECTS: AIR, WATER and SOIL

- AIR includes issues related to air quality, greenhouse gases, active mobility and public transit.
- WATER includes issues related to drinking water conservation and the management of wastewater and rainwater.
- SOIL includes issues related to waste management, soil and shoreline protection and revitalization, heat islands and forest heritage.

#### 2) SOCIAL ASPECTS

- This mainly concerns ensuring social acceptability when implementing actions or initiatives to protect the environment.

#### 3) ECONOMIC ASPECTS

- The main aim is to reconcile the economic viability of a project with the preservation of the environment and social cohesion.

### **Required profiles**

Candidates must be residents of Rosemère and have significant expertise in environmental or sustainable development issues. More specifically, the Town of Rosemère is looking for:

- Three residents with very strong expertise or interest in one of the three environmental focuses: air, water and soil
- A resident demonstrating a high-level of social acceptability toward the environment
- A resident with expertise in the field of responsible economy

A selection committee will choose potential candidates for an interview in order to make recommendations to Town Council.
