



## BY-LAW ON THE USE OF THE ECOCENTRE

### Eligibility

- Residents of Rosemère only
  - Free access
  - Requirements: ID with photo and proof of residency with address
- Passenger vehicles for personal use only
  - Cars, pick-up trucks, SUVs, mini-vans
  - With or without trailer
    - **Exception:** use of any tipping system of a trailer is prohibited
  - Overall length of 11.4 m or less
- Company vehicles or vehicles with commercial registration (F licence plate) are prohibited
  - Exception: residents of Rosemère wishing to dispose of construction, renovation or demolition materials from their personal residence only
    - Requirement: construction or renovation permit issued by the Town
  - No green waste can be accepted using this type of vehicle.

### Business hours

- **April to November**
  - Monday, CLOSED
  - Tuesday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
  - Saturday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
  - Sunday, 9 a.m. till noon
  - CLOSED on statutory holidays**
- **December to March**
  - Sunday and Monday, CLOSED
  - Tuesday to Saturday, 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
  - CLOSED on statutory holidays**

### Materials accepted

- **Cumbersome items**
  - Mattresses and boxsprings, furniture, household appliances, bathtubs, sinks, toilets, etc.
- **IT and communication products**
  - Computers, screens, printers, digital scanners, fax machines, ink cartridges, TVs, cellular and conventional telephones, e-book readers, VHS tapes, DVDs and Blu-ray, VCRs, optical scanners, audio or video equipment, cameras, etc.
- **Recyclable materials**
  - Paper, cardboard, plastic, metal, glass.
- **Construction, renovation and demolition materials**
  - Wood, gypsum board, melamine, asphalt shingles, aggregates (diameter under 45 cm), brick, flat glass, metal, ceramic.
- **Old tires**
  - Road vehicle tires, with or without rims (rim diameter of 62.23 cm or 24.5 in. or less) and an overall diameter of 83.82 cm or 33 in. or less.
- **Hazardous domestic waste (HDW)**
  - Adhesives, tar, epoxy, strippers, used oil, paint, chemical products, batteries, solvents, propane tanks (40-litre or less), fluorescent bulbs, pesticides, aerosols, chlorine, gas, fuel, etc.
- **Green waste**
  - Dead leaves, garden or weeding waste, small branches (less than 1 cm in diameter and less than 60 cm in length), grass clippings.

## **Materials refused**

- **Domestic waste**
- **Branches and soil**
  - Exception: branches with a diameter of 1 cm or less and 60 cm or less in length.
- **Materials other than those posted at the entrance**
- **Materials presenting a risk to the health of users and employees or the environment**
  - PCBs, fireworks or others.

## **Regulations relating to the disposal of eligible materials**

- **Sorting of materials**
  - The user must sort materials before taking them to the ecocentre in order to facilitate their placement in the appropriate locations and containers.
- **Size of materials**
  - All materials must be of a size that allows them to be deposited in a container.
- **Unloading by ecocentre personnel**
  - Ecocentre personnel is not allowed to help with the unloading of materials.
- **Pouring liquids**
  - It is prohibited to pour liquids on ecocentre premises.
- **Placement of materials**
  - End-users must place materials where indicated by the ecocentre's personnel.
- **Container identification**
  - All HDW must be identified by the user on the container in which it is deposited in the ecocentre.
- **Signage**
  - All end-users are required to comply with signs on the site.
- **Turning off the engine**
  - All end-users must turn off their vehicle's engine before unloading materials.
- **Property of materials**
  - All materials deposited at the ecocentre become the property of the Town of Rosemère and cannot subsequently be reclaimed.
- **Crushing and dismantling**
  - No crushing or dismantling activities can be conducted on site.
- **Depositing materials outside business hours**
  - No materials can be deposited inside or outside the ecocentre outside of business hours.
- **Number of vehicles present on the site**
  - Ecocentre personnel can limit the number of vehicles present on the site.

## **Rules of conduct at the ecocentre**

- **Prohibitions**
  - Smoking, the use of a lighter, match or other item of that nature
  - Climbing into the containers
  - Moving outside prescribed areas
  - Using verbal or physical violence
  - Damaging furnishings.
- **Ecocentre exclusions**
  - Ecocentre personnel can refuse access to, or exclude any person using verbal or physical violence or deliberately damaging furnishings on site.
- **Space around vehicles**
  - End-users must clean the area around their vehicle before leaving the ecocentre.
- **Children**
  - Children under the age of 12 must remain in the vehicle or be held by the hand.
