

Recap of Municipal Council decisions at the regular meeting of January 11, 2016.

URBAN PLANNING BY-LAWS

The Council adopted the following bylaws:

- By-law amending By-law 801 -Zoning, to include measures countering the spread of the emerald ash borer.
- By-law amending By-law 808 -Permits and Certificates, modifying rates for permits and certificates.

OTHER BY-LAW

The Council also adopted the following by-law:

 By-law 873 - By-law relating to measures against the spread of the emerald ash borer.

GENERAL MANAGEMENT, HUMAN RESOURCES AND COMMUNICATIONS

Renewal of the agreement on the Employee Assistance Program with the firm of *Homewood Solutions Humaines* in the amount of \$3,528 (taxes extra).

TECHNICAL SERVICES, PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC HYGIENE

A contract for the cleaning and video inspection of sanitary and storm sewers in 2016 was granted to the lowest bidder, i.e. the firm of *National Vacuum Inc.*, for a total amount of \$60,580 (taxes extra).

COMMUNITY SERVICES

The Municipal Council authorized Maison Adhémar-Dion to use Charbonneau Park for its fundraising activity — Dragon Boat Race — on June 11, 2016.

The following grants were awarded:

- \$1,000 to the 49th Lorraine-Rosemère Scout Troop for 2015.
- \$1,000 to the Thérèse-De Blainville RCM's Consortium jeunesse.
- \$500 to the Association Régionale de Loisirs pour Personnes handicapées des Laurentides (Regional Association for the Disabled) for 2016.
- \$250 to Le Mitan (women's shelter).
- \$500 to the Maison des soins palliatifs de la Rivière-du-Nord (North Shore Palliative Care Centre).
- \$150 to Saint-Luc Parish for its fundraising dinner of February 12, 2016.
