COUNCIL

- The Town of Rosemère supported the recommendations of the “Union des municipalités du Québec” (UMQ - Union of Québec Municipalities) and asked the government of Québec to modify proposed Bill 106, *An Act to implement the 2030 Energy Policy and to amend various legislative provisions*.

GENERAL MANAGEMENT/HUMAN

- Appointment of Edith Julien to the position of part-time Library loans officer.
- Appointment of Mickaël Boisjoli to the position of technician-operator, drinking water, 5th operator, night shift.

LEGAL SERVICES

- In compliance with the law, the Town clerk was instructed, in cases of non-payment of taxes due, to sell at auction, properties on the treasurer’s list to October 11, 2016.

TECHNICAL SERVICES/PUBLIC WORKS/
PUBLIC HYGIENE

The following contracts were renewed:

- Maintenance of outdoor skating rinks with Gestion Unisol Inc., in the approximate amount of \$35,817.50 plus taxes.
- Supply, pick-up and disposal of containers with Conteneurs Services Matrec Inc., based on unit prices, for an approx. total of \$148,747.00 for 2017 and \$151,907.00 for 2018, plus taxes.
- Street cleaning using vacuum sweepers with Entretiens J.R. Villeneuve Inc., based on unit prices, for an approx. total of \$32,750.00 for 2017 and \$33,000.00 for 2018, plus taxes.
- Pavement markings with Entreprise Techline Inc., based on unit prices, for an approx. total of \$48,112.06 for 2017 and \$49,420.94 for 2018, plus taxes.
