



## ***Summary of Municipal Council decisions at the regular Council meeting of November 14, 2016***

Mayor's report on the Town's financial situation and tabling of the list of contracts concluded during the course of the last year involving more than \$25,000 and contacts involving more than \$2,000, which total more than \$25,000.

### **OTHER BY-LAW**

The following by-law was adopted:

- By-law modifying by-law 873 on measures for countering the spread of the emerald ash borer.

### **COUNCIL**

- Councillor Normand Corriveau was appointed mayor pro-tem from December 2016 to March 2017 inclusively.

### **FINANCE**

The Town's budgetary forecasts and financial contributions to the following organizations for the 2017 fiscal year were adopted:

- The *Régie intermunicipale d'assainissement des eaux de Rosemère et de Lorraine* (Intermunicipal Water Treatment

Board) in the amount of \$2,385,800 and the Town's financial contribution of \$975,500.

- The *Conseil intermunicipal de transport Laurentides* (Public Transit Corporation) in the amounts of \$47,186,080 for regular transportation and \$4,749,855 for paratransit, and the Town's financial contribution in the amount of \$1,679,043 for regular transportation (train and bus), as well as \$82,063 for paratransit.
- The *Régie intermunicipale de police Thérèse-De Blainville* (Police Board) in the amount of \$24,029,481 and \$4,158,651 representing the Town of Rosemère's contribution for 2017.

### **TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS / PUBLIC HYGIENE**

- The Town of Rosemère asked Québec's Ministry of Transport, Urban Mobility and Electrification of Transportation to review the safety for cyclists and pedestrians on Labelle Boulevard (R-17) and along Autoroute 640 (A-640), particularly in the area bordered by Bouthillier Street, Autoroute 640, René-A. Robert Boulevard and Roland-Durand Boulevard on its territory.

The following contracts and mandates were awarded:

- Contract SC-101 – Development of *Place des jeunes* awarded to Les Entreprises V.G. Inc. for a total amount of \$603,905.50 plus taxes,

subject to the entry into force of borrowing by-law 880.

- TP-113 – Pneumatic excavation of valve access and service boxes awarded to Aquarehab (Canada) Inc. based on a unit price, for a total amount of approximately \$33,135.00 plus taxes for 2017 and \$34,105.00 plus taxes for 2018.

### **COMMUNITY SERVICES**

As a supporter of the *Regroupement pour un Québec en santé* (Group for a healthy Québec), the Town of Rosemère asked the provincial government to:

- Pursue and increase investments in the creation of an environment conducive to healthy living habits while fostering a reduction in the consumption of products harmful to the health of Quebecers:
  - a) by increasing the tax on tobacco products in an effort to reduce smoking.
  - a) By implementing a tax on sugary beverages in order to reduce the consumption of sugar.
- Invest revenues in the implementation of an ambitious and motivating plan calling for the creation of environments fostering the integration of healthy lifestyle habits in the daily living environments of all Quebecers.

The following sponsorships/grants/donations were authorized:

- a) \$10,663.38 - 2016 grant (558 players at \$19.11 /player) – Lorraine-Rosemère Soccer Association.
