



*Summary of Municipal
Council decisions at the
regular Council meeting of
February 13, 2017*

BY-LAWS

- Adoption of By-law 885 authorizing a loan of \$528,000 to cover expenses related to the master plans on networks and waterworks as well as traffic studies, urban plans and architectural and landscaping analyses.

**GENERAL MANAGEMENT/HUMAN
RESOURCES/ COMMUNICATIONS**

- A 2.3% salary increase for the year 2017 was granted to managers and non-unionized administrative personnel, retroactive to January 1, 2017.
- A 2.3% increase was granted to cultural and administrative professors, retroactive to January 1, 2017.
- An agreement concluded between the Town of Rosemère and the Canadian Union of Public Employees, local 4756 was ratified and the general manager as well as the director of Human Resources were authorized to sign the collective agreement, which is effective from

January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2019.

- Adoption of a resolution declaring the third week of each year to be “Hooked on School Days” in the Town of Rosemère and supporting PERL (Partners for academic success in the Laurentians) as well as all partners working to cut school drop-out rates and make the Laurentians a persevering region that values education as a lever for the development of its communities and is committed to taking significant measures to this end.

LEGAL SERVICES

- Renewal of the agreement for services to victims of disasters between the Red Cross and the Town of Rosemère and authorizing the mayor or the mayor pro-tem and the town clerk or assistant town clerk to sign the letter of agreement for and on behalf of the Town of Rosemère.

**TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS
/ PUBLIC HYGIENE**

The following contracts were awarded:

- 2017 arboricultural work on ash trees in the Town of Rosemère to “Services d’arbres Nature inc.”, based on unit pricing, for a total amount of approximately \$95,964 plus taxes.
- 2017 maintenance of street lighting, parks, parking lots and playgrounds, to the firm of Laurin Laurin (1991) Inc., based on unit pricing, for an amount of approximately \$38,758 plus taxes.

- Supply and delivery of: MG-20 crushed stone, 0-5 mm sifted stone, 10-20 mm BC clean stone, AB-5 abrasive stone, for the year 2017, to Groupe TNT Inc., based on unit pricing, for a total amount of approximately \$38,283.50 plus taxes.
- Supply and delivery of: class A sand and class AB-10 sprinkle sand (winter maintenance) for the year 2017, to Uniroc Inc., based on unit pricing, for a total amount of approximately \$19,579 plus taxes.
- TreeAzin treatment against the emerald ash borer for the year 2017, to Novafor inc., based on unit pricing, for a total amount of approximately \$16,575.58 plus taxes.
- Repairs to the coagulation basin at the Town of Rosemère's water treatment plant to Les Entreprises Daniel Letarte et fils inc, for a total amount of \$14,449.84 plus taxes and the financing of this expense from the non-allocated accumulated surplus.
- Lorraine – Rosemère Soccer Club, for a 5-year period.
- Hockey féminin des Laurentides (women's hockey) for a 3-year period.
- Lorraine – Rosemère Minor Hockey, for a 5-year period.
- L'ENVOL Diving Club, for a two-year period.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

The following grants, financial contributions, sponsorships and donations were awarded:

- \$145/athlete – Grant for the 2017 winter edition of the Jeux du Québec (Québec Games)
- \$750 - 2017 grant – Société d'histoire et de généalogie des Mille-Îles (history and genealogy society)
- \$10,000 as a start-up budget to the organization CatChat (stray cats).
