



*Summary of Municipal
Council decisions at the
regular Council meeting of
March 13, 2017*

URBAN PLANNING

The following by-laws were adopted:

- By-law project amending By-law 801 - Zoning, to modify standards for accessory constructions authorized for service stations: addition of a windshield washer island on the side yard or backyard.
- By-law project amending by-law 801 - Zoning, to modify measures relating to daycare services in a home environment.
- By-law authorizing complete infrastructure rehabilitation work on Hector Street, from Grande-Côte Road to the southern tip, along with an expense and corresponding loan of \$796,000 to cover the costs.
- By-law authorizing development work on Rosenbloom Lacroix and Longstaff parks, along with an expense and corresponding loan of \$476,000 to cover the costs.
- By-law authorizing development work at Charbonneau Park for the installation of water games, playground equipment, repairs to an outdoor skating rink, and the replacement of the synthetic soccer surface, along with an expense and corresponding loan of \$2,283,000 to cover the costs.

OTHER BY-LAWS

The following by-laws were adopted:

- By-law modifying by-law 878 authorizing the construction of a pumping station for rainwater catchment basins 9 and 10 as well as a \$924,000 loan to cover their costs, in order to increase the expenditure and borrow an amount of \$495,000, bringing the total to \$1,419,000.
- By-law authorizing work on a rainwater collection system, including the rehabilitation of ditches on Roland-Durand Blvd. from De la Lande Street to Des Prés, along with an expense and corresponding loan of \$5,444,000 to cover the costs.

COUNCIL

- Councillor Kateri Lesage was named mayor pro tem from April 1st, 2017 to the end of the Council's mandate. She is also authorized to serve as a substitute on the Board of the Thérèse-De Blainville RCM, for the duration of her mandate as mayor pro tem.
- It was resolved that April be proclaimed Daffodil Month, and that the public be urged to generously support the Canadian Cancer Society.

TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS PUBLIC HYGIENE

The following contracts were awarded:

- The following agreements were authorized:
 - a) An agreement was concluded between the Town and the Rosemère Cultural and Sports Development Corporation (CDCSR), providing a framework for the latter's contribution to the construction of Place des jeunes.
 - b) It was resolved that the mayor or mayor pro tem and the town clerk or assistant town clerk be authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the Town of Rosemère.
 - c) Renewal of the agreement with the Tricentris sorting centre, for the processing of recyclable materials collected on the territory of the Town of Rosemère, covering the period from April 14, 2017 to April 14, 2022.

- d) It was resolved that the mayor or mayor pro tem or the town clerk or assistant town clerk be authorized to sign the memorandum of understanding on behalf of the Town.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

- Within the framework of the program of assistance to independent public libraries for the development of collections, it was resolved that Marc Bineault, Head of the Library Division, be authorized to sign and submit to the Ministry of Culture and Communication, for and on behalf of the Town of Rosemère, an application for financial assistance for the year 2017.
- The Town of Rosemère authorized the holding of the 2nd edition of the "Food Truck" event benefitting the Drapeau and Deschambault Foundation, to be held on June 8, 2017.

The following grants, financial contributions, sponsorships and donations were authorized:

- a) \$1,000 - 2017 sponsorship - Triolet Foundation - 15th edition of the fundraising concert.
- b) \$250 - Donation - Collège Lionel-Groulx Foundations - 2017 Gala Méritas.

- f) \$250 - 2017 grant - Laurentian Centre for Assistance to Persons with Traumatic Brain Injury or a Physical Disability (CAPTCHPL).
- g) \$1,000 - 2017 grant - 49th Lorraine-Rosemère Scout Troop.
- h) 10 tables - Donation - St-Luc Parish.
- i) \$100 - Donation - Rosemère High School - Casino night.
