



*Summary of Municipal  
Council decisions at the  
regular Council meeting of  
April 10, 2017*

**URBAN PLANNING**

The following by-laws were adopted:

- By-law modifying By-law 801 - Zoning, to alter the standards applicable to air conditioning units and heat pumps.
- By-law modifying By-law 801 - Zoning, to alter standards applicable to accessory constructions allowed for service stations, i.e. the addition of a windshield washer island in the side or back yard.
- By-law modifying By-law 801 - Zoning, to reduce the P-149 zone and enlarge the H-15 zone, which is located on Des Mèlèzes and De L'Obier streets, and measures approximately 7 metres wide by 30 metres deep. This modification will allow the construction of a single-family home.
- By-law modifying By-law 801 - Zoning, to allow childcare services in residential areas and certain commercial and public zones, with the exception of zones where two-family and multi-family dwellings are located.
- Adoption of By-law 890 for the replacement of vehicles, defective water meters and building maintenance, as well as an

expenditure and loan of \$550,000 to cover their costs.

**COUNCIL**

- Authorization for the mayor and two councillors to attend the annual meeting of the UMQ (Union of Québec municipalities).
- Proclaiming the week of May 1 to 7, 2017 as "Mental Health Week" in the Town of Rosemère.
- Proclaiming the week of April 24 to 30, 2017 as "Public Rail Safety Week".

**LEGAL AFFAIRS**

- Town of Rosemère joining forces with the UMQ in a public call for insurance proposals providing the most attractive conditions and prices for non-profit organizations recognized by the Town.
- Service agreement between the Town of Rosemère and the Thérèse-De Blainville Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCITB) for the creation of a temporary position for a liaison officer.

**TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS  
/ PUBLIC HYGIENE**

The following contract was awarded:

- Maintenance work on the structure of the Île Ducharme bridge awarded to the Nobesco company, based on unit pricing for a total amount of approximately \$150,917.25 plus taxes.
