



*Summary of Municipal  
Council decisions at the  
regular Council meeting of  
September 12, 2017*

**GENERAL MANAGEMENT / HUMAN  
RESOURCES / COMMUNICATIONS**

- It was resolved to direct Telus to inform the Town prior to the installation of telecommunication equipment on its territory, as well ask Telus to act as a “good corporate citizen” by taking into account the opinion of citizens and the Town affected by the installation of its telecommunication equipment.
- As an expression of its support to the family of Catherine Frochoux, library attendant, who died of cancer on August 19, the Town of Rosemère donated \$300 to the Canadian Cancer Society’s “Paws for Hope” campaign, and urged employees of the Town of Rosemère to show their support by donating to the cause.
- The Town congratulated Francine Bélanger, assistant town clerk, on obtaining the title of “officier municipal agréé” (OMA - certified municipal officer) from the “Corporation des officiers municipaux agréés du Québec” (COMAQ - Québec Corporation of Certified Municipal Officers).

**LEGAL AFFAIRS**

- Renewal of the lease with St-Luc Parish for the rental of parking space at Sainte-Françoise-Cabrini Church for commuter train passengers, for a one-year period retroactive to September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 until August 31, 2018 at the same monthly rate, i.e. \$500 plus taxes, and at the same conditions.
- Renewal of the agreement with the “Réseau de transport métropolitain” (RTM - Metropolitan Transportation Network) for its contribution to the operating costs of the Rosemère train station’s “Park and Ride” lot at Sainte-Françoise-Cabrini Church, for a one-year period retroactive to September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to August 31, 2018, at the same terms and conditions as the previous year, i.e. an amount of \$6,600 paid by the RTM.

**TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS  
/ PUBLIC HYGIENE**

- Awarding of the snow clearing contract for the territory of the Town of Rosemère for the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 seasons to the lowest compliant bidder, i.e. Pavage Dion Inc., based on unit pricing, for a total amount of approximately \$429,600 plus taxes for the 2017-2018 season.
- Awarding of the contract for the renovation of the existing soccer field at Charbonneau Park and the installation of the new artificial turf to the lowest compliant bidder, i.e. Les Entreprises V.G. Inc., for a total amount of \$393,922 plus taxes.

## COMMUNITY SERVICES

- The following sponsorship was approved:
  - a) \$550 (\$250 sponsorship and \$300 for the purchase of a table (10 tickets) - Drapeau & Deschambault Foundation - 2017 spaghetti dinner.
  
- The Town of Rosemère committed to the self-financing of the project for the development of the collections of independent public libraries for the year 2017, until it obtains financial assistance from the Québec Ministry of Culture and Communications.
