



*Summary of Municipal
Council decisions at the
regular Council meeting of
December 11, 2017*

Council

Adoption of a resolution proclaiming zero tolerance for violence against women on the territory of the Town of Rosemère and declaring Rosemère a municipal ally in the fight against violence toward women.

FINANCE

- Adoption of the projected \$24,854,911 budget presented by the "Régie intermunicipale de police Thérèse-De Blainville" (Police Board) for the 2018 fiscal year and the contribution of an amount of \$4,273,327, which represents the Town of Rosemère's share for the year 2018.
- Adoption of a resolution calling for the staggering of taxable property values, further to the tabling of the 2018-2019-2020 real estate evaluation roll, in compliance with article 253.27 of the Act respecting municipal taxation.

TECHNICAL SERVICES / PUBLIC WORKS

- Acceptance of the joint "Projet B.R.C.D.T. # 10 001" service proposal submitted by COBAMIL and the research and technological development centre of Montréal's École Polytechnique, for a study on the vulnerability of drinking water sources to be carried out according to regulations on water sampling and its protection, at a cost of \$55,019 representing Rosemère's contribution to the project.

The following contracts were awarded:

- A professional service mandate for the production of call for tenders documents and the supervision of rehabilitation of 3 wastewater pumping stations in the Town of Rosemère, to the lowest compliant bidder, i.e., Asisto Inc., for a total amount of \$43,278 plus taxes.
- A contract for the analysis of wastewater and dewatered sewage sludge from the treatment plant, to the lowest compliant bidder, i.e. Eurofins Essais Environnementaux, based on unit pricing, for a total approximate amount of \$16,697 plus taxes

- A contract for arboricultural work on ash trees in the Town of Rosemère, to the lowest compliant bidder, i.e. Service d'arbres Nature inc., based on unit pricing, for a total approximate amount of \$92,201 plus taxes.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

The following grant was authorized:

- \$2,000 (\$500/athlete) for Rosemère gymnasts.
