I am especially proud of presenting a recap of investments in the rehabilitation of our infrastructures carried out over the past five years. This overview will enable you to note the scope of work conducted since 2006 as well as work planned for 2011.

These investments help improve our quality of life by optimizing the management of our drinking water. In fact, our efforts in this area have translated in a significant reduction in water loss due to leaks and breaks in our waterworks system. As a result, since 2004, the number of breaks has dropped by a remarkable 80%. It should also be noted that, in 2010, our use of a new structural rehabilitation technology involving ultraviolet rays in the curing of a sewer pipe earned us, in conjunction with the Town of Magog, the UMQ's *Ovation municipale* award in the Environment and Sustainable Development category.

You can rest assured that these major projects respected both our budget and our taxpayers' ability to pay. Moreover, by remaining constantly abreast of new government grant programs, of the total \$14.3 million investment in the rehabilitation of our infrastructures, the Town was able to secure a contribution of \$6.5 million from the federal and provincial governments.

This summer, yet again, major roadwork will be carried out on Grande-Côte and Lorraine Street. Aware of the inconveniences inherent in projects of this nature, I would like to thank you, once more, for your customary patience and collaboration during the work period.
